

Wharton Fellowship Hall Room Use Guidelines

Welcome to Covenant Presbyterian Church and Wharton Fellowship Hall. This room has recently undergone extensive renovation and updating for the enjoyment and use of our members and guests. We ask that you treat the room and furnishings with care and respect, as it is part of our church and God's house.

Please follow the guidelines shown below for the use of this hall:

1. Return all chairs and tables to the storage closet after use. Carts are available for your use in moving and storing chairs.
2. If you utilize any partition panels for your meeting, they must be folded carefully and returned to the storage closet.
3. Any toys must be stored after use.
4. Furniture (pews, tables, etc.) must be moved back as you found them

The following items are prohibited in Wharton Fellowship Hall

1. Throwing of any objects, including balls, shoes and/or toys
2. Helium Balloons
3. Food or drinks containing red dye (Red punch, Kool-aid, Red Jello, Big Red Soft Drinks, etc.)
4. Tape of ANY kind, including masking and duct tape is strictly prohibited on the carpet and/or walls.

No church property is to leave the building without prior approval of the fellowship or property committee.
